**Day 5: Friday, April 13, 2012  
Maastricht - Floriade - Cruising**

Today your ship docks in Maastricht where you will have some time to explore this oldest, continually-inhabited city in the Netherlands. It was here that the present-day European Union was founded over 50 years ago. The city is famous for its ancient fortifications, city market square and restored port area. Later, journey to the Floriade Horticultural Exposition, a world-famous floral and cultural event held in the Netherlands only once per decade.
